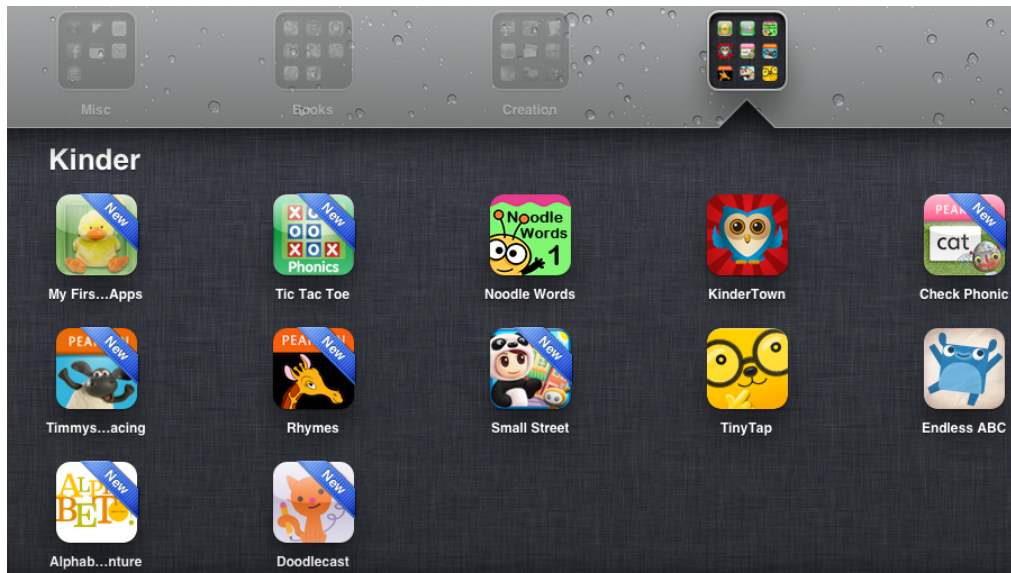


ECE/Kinder/1st Grade Apps Ideas



Additional: (I did not download all)

- Little Writer – letter tracing, numbers, shapes free
- Tiny Tap – you can record over images and have students follow directions
- I write words Lite
- My 1st words flashcards cost
- Phonics tic tac toe
- Learn Numbers
- Abcy math Bingo - cost
- Endless ABC – drag the letters to the word and they all perform that word when done
- Noodle Words – higher level – sight words come up and the bees DO whatever the word is to promote understanding - cost
- I like books ebooks
- Istory books - free
- Dr. Seuss Books – interactive books- cost
- Doodle buddy – art - free
- Kids Piano Lite – music –lite is free
- Wee Sing - music
- Seuss Band – music
- Kidscal – visual calculator with variety of voices

***Kindertown is a wonderful review tool by age level – search by topic, scroll down and read review and see demo – if you want it continue to scroll down and it takes you directly to it within the app store – search by free or pay for apps – box to sign up keeps coming up but just keep closing it – it is a free site although you can subscribe for more features. Apps for every educator:

- **Educreations** or **Show Me** – import images and write on
- **Stick pick**- set up your students by blooms level and it randomly generates a name to call on with bloom level appropriate question stems specific for that student
- **Explain Everything**
- **Common Core** - standards
- ****Symbaloo bookmark**- NOT an app but very useful on your ipad -rather than book mark websites – create a symbaloo account on a computer- bookmark all your websites. Then bookmark symbaloo on your ipad. You can also download the symbaloo app for your phone

Cool Apps all grade levels

- **Sock puppets** – create puppet show with sock puppets to teach students a concept or for them to teach their classmates or demonstrate their mastery
- **Fotobabble** - images
- **Comic Touch**- import images and add speech bubbles
- **Bill Atkinson Photo cards** – generate email-able postcards you can record over – 1st grade teacher uses these to email students before school starts to introduce herself
- **Audio Boo** to record student work

When you go to the itunes store, set up a separate account for your school ipad. To search for apps select education and check out the squares for teacher apps, special education, middle school, math, science, etc. You MUST purchase an app for every ipad you put it on in order to be legal – prices go down significantly with volume purchasing. Just FYI -There are both district and legal ramifications if you do not.

Remember ...

At the end of every session double click your home button to see all the open apps – hold one till they wiggle – press the red minus– sign to close each one out. This improves how your ipad runs.

To take a screen shot of what is on your ipad – kids work etc, hold the home button and click the power switch – it will be saved to your camera roll.

- Mad Libs – same as paper copy
- Iworld Geography – atlas worth exploring
- Body Organs 4 kids
- Science 360- images only but great discussion point

- Toontastic- generate cartoons
- Sparkle fish record a story and fill in missing words adj, verbs
- Fotopedia- incredible images – heritage, women of the world, national parks, wild friends
- Nature Tap- images of animals and where they live – info plus sounds – very cool
- Stack the States- learn the states game
- Grammar (barrons painless grammar) older students
- Grammaropolis nouns verb adj fun exploration
