
Awesome EXIT or QUIZ tool..........Google Docs Form Directions:

Create a google form and have kids fill it out and the data goes directly to a spreadsheet so you have your hard data. Free service. Go to google.com and select MORE – then google docs. Sign up for a free acct with your current email.

This form can be embedded in a wiki, emailed, or viewed as a link posted on your class computer or website. There are 71 themes to choose from to make it cool!

Steps: This is the first screen you see which has all the documents you are sharing with others listed.



The screen looks like below, Add a Title with any notations you have for the takers


Type in your question – use the help text for clarification – **FIRST QUESTION** \*HOULD BE THEIR NAME !!!!!


Select your question type – you can use a variety of question types

Hit DONE when you are ready – you can make it a required question which will not let students submit unless all are answered. Then select ADD ITEM to creat the next question.

When you hover over a question some editing choices come up – use the pencil to edit the question, the papers to

duplicate it, and the trashcan to delete it.

Other choices for email etc are here Once you create your quiz, then you need to get it somewhere – whether it is emailed as a link, posted on a wiki, set up on a website – see me for the how to's of any of those !!!!

The data goes into a spread sheet that you can then manipulate – think about your questions so you have all the information you might need to chart – Name, Grade, What do you really want to see or compare?
